

Indian Trail Student Arrival and Dismissal Procedures



Student Drop-off at Indian Trail for 2017-2018 will be from 8:50-8:59. There is no guaranteed supervision for children arriving before 8:50, so please do not drop children off earlier than 8:50.

From 8:50-8:59, students will enter the school utilizing doors 15 and 11.

Students arriving after the 9:00 tardy bell MUST enter the school through the main entrance (by the flagpole). All other doors are closed and locked at 9:00 for security purposes.

Parents may drop off their children in the “circle drive” located on the north side of the building. You must remain in your car at all times while in the circle drive. You will form two lines until you come to the first turn. There will be a staff member there to merge you into one line. After the merge, PARENTS ARE TO PULL AS FAR FORWARD AS POSSIBLE between the cones to drop off their children. Students may exit the car as soon as the sidewalk begins even if they are not right at the school door. The longer you wait to let them out, the later they will be for class. When parents cooperate with staff, we do not have drop-off safety concerns.

If you prefer to walk your child to the door you may park in the west parking lot that is accessible from 78th Avenue. This is not a “circle drive,” so park in designated spaces. Students will walk past the playground and enter the building through door 11 (near bike racks). Please note that the 78th avenue driveway is also the bus exit. When you enter from 78th avenue, you must turn immediately into the designated parking spaces.

Parents are not allowed to stop along Frankfort Square Road to drop off or pick up their children. This section’s curbs are clearly painted yellow and signage indicates “No Parking.” The Will County Sheriff’s Deputies informed the school they intend to be regularly present and issue tickets to violators. Most important, it is essential that cars not park or stop curbside in this zone since it restricts driver and pedestrian visibility.

Please also be aware that Frankfort Square Road by the school and the school parking lots are cell phone free. This is state law. The deputies can issue tickets to drivers using cell phones in school zones. We do take down license plates of those not following the state law. This is in an effort to protect the students.

Parents are not to use the driveway or parking lot on the south side of building (at Inverary Rd). Except for days when we have big events. This is for staff parking and buses only.

Children that walk to school will only cross the street at the Frankfort Square Rd/Acorn Ridge intersection accompanied by the crossing guard. Students are not to cross the street at Hickory

Creek/Frankfort Square Rd intersection (in front of the school) without a parent or guardian escorting them.

At the end of the day, we ask that you continue to follow the expectations:

- First Graders exit doors 15
- Second Graders exit door 15
- Third Graders exit door 11
- Fourth Graders exit door 10
- Remain in your car while in the circle drive
- Pull forward as far as you can
- Park in a designated parking space, exit the car and escort your child back to the car
- If you park and/or walk to pick your child, stand close to the exit doors, so your child can see you easily and be quickly escorted to the car or crossing guard
- Refrain from double parking or parking in no parking zones
- Do not use your cell phone
- Follow all directions by the staff
- Be respectful to all Trailblazer students and staff

I understand that your little ones often times like to run around while they are waiting, please do not allow them to run through the landscaping or play by the school sign.

Pets are only allowed on the sidewalk closest to Frankfort Square Road.
