Board of Education receives 2016-17 financial audit report

At the October 11 meeting, the Board was presented with highlights of the District's FY17 annual financial audit. Mack and Associates informed Board members that the District's overall financial position continues to remain strong. Total fund balances increased by \$686,441 from the prior year. The District received an unmodified, unqualified opinion on its audited financial statements and the auditors noted only minor areas for improvement in the District's financial operations. District auditors also commended the District on its internal control practices and procedures.

In personnel matters, the Board

- approved the employment of Kathryn Behrens as a substitute nurse and Megan Urbanczyk as a paraprofessional;
- acknowledged the retirement of Building and Grounds/Maintenance Manager Jim Jakubowski; and
- accepted the resignation of Amanda Lindsay.

In other matters, the Board

- heard a presentation and watched a video of a newscast created by the Indian Trail Newspaper and Technology Club;
- recognized building administrators in honor of National Principals Month;
- authorized publication of notice of the 2017 levy hearing to be held at 7 p.m. on December 13, 2017;
- authorized the Superintendent to publish the FY17 Annual Statement of Affairs;
- approved the first reading of Board Policy 2:210, 2:260, 4:70, 6:80, 6:180, 6:210, 6:290, 6:330, 7:80, 7:160, and 8:70;
- approved a resolution to declare unneeded items as surplus; and
- heard that the extended year program will run from June 19, 2018 through July 25, 2018.
