- Proof of Income:
Printouts from: public aid, social security, unemployment, food stamps, link card, check stub, or medical card.
- Verification of Address:
Current utility bill and/or government mail showing Will County address

Any child attending the fair **MUST be accompanied by an adult. If parent/guardian is unable to attend, an adult representative must bring all documentation noted above for the absent parent and children.**
