## THE CUB SCOUTING PROGRAM

The Cub Scout Program is a year-round program that boys and girls can join at any time - It's flexible enough to work with other programs that Scouts may also be involved in.

**LION CUBS** (entering Kindergarten)

**TIGER CUBS** (entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade)

Oriented to Scouts and parents. Work on big ideas to search, discover, and share. Scouts and parents work one on one with other families.

**CUB SCOUTS** (entering 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grades)

Family centered program. Scouts meet regularly in small groups to work on projects. Learning is achieved through an advancement program. Uniforms, badges, games, sports, and FUN!

**WEBELOS SCOUTS** (entering 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades)

Begin outdoor experiences. Scouts meet regularly with adult leaders. Learning is achieved through a hobby and life skills program called activity badges.
