

	Skill Focus	Time/Resources Used/Explanation
Day 1	Place Value	10 minutes—I did three problems from a worksheet in the folders. Then I practiced online using the “Place Value Soccer Game.”
Day 2	Multiplication Facts & Writing Numbers	20 minutes—I quizzed myself using the “Mastering Math Facts” worksheet. I watched a video on the Weebly page for writing numbers in word form and practiced using the game “Write Numbers.”
Day 3	Rounding	15 minutes—I worked on the “challenge” worksheet from school. Then I played a rounding game from school with my sister.
Day 4	Place Value & Writing Numbers	15 minutes— I watched a video on how to write numbers all three ways. Then I practiced using a worksheet from the folders at school.

REFLECTION/COMMENTS: I'm doing really well with standard and expanded form. I still need a little practice with word form, but I'm doing better. I did great with my math facts, so I only practiced one day. I will practice more next week with the harder problems. I really liked playing the rounding game with my sister. She remembers rounding from last year.

	Skill Focus	Time/Resources Used/Explanation
Day 1	Overall comprehension	15 minutes—Read “Percy Jackson” to self. Retold story to Grandma, while Grandma asked questions about the characters and events.
Day 2	Text Features	15 minutes—Watched slideshow on Weebly webpage. Practiced skill using text features game. Looked for a diagram in my nonfiction “tigers” book and explained what each part was.
Day 3	Vocabulary	10 minutes—Dad quizzed me on each vocabulary word using flashcards. I wrote sentences using the vocabulary words.
Day 4	Nonfiction Comprehension	20 minutes—I reread the passages “Underground Railroad” and “Missouri Compromise.” I had my brother ask me questions about the passage. Then I watched a video on the underground railroad from the Weebly website.

REFLECTION/COMMENTS: I did really well with my overall comprehension and text features. I need to spend more time next week practicing my vocabulary words and reviewing the Missouri Compromise. I really like the Percy Jackson book.
