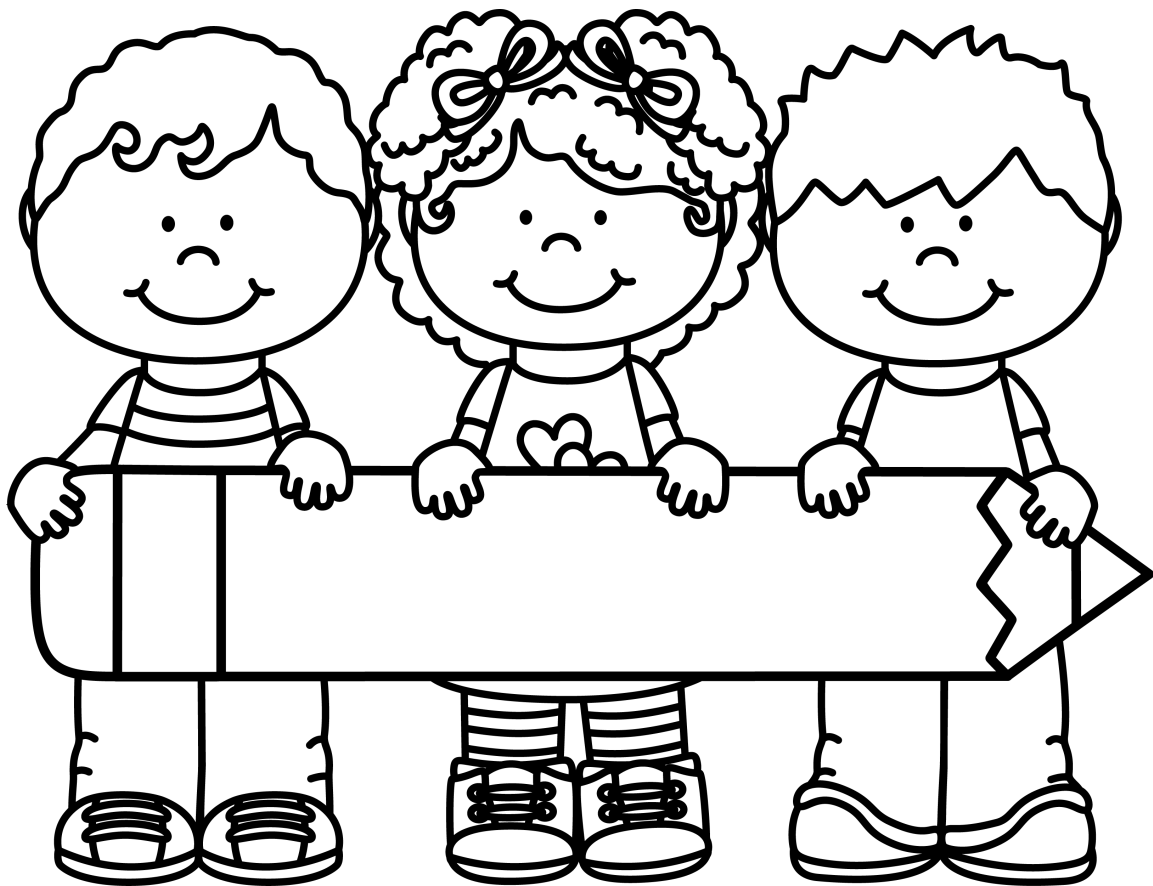

# Types of Poetry



## Acrostic

An acrostic poem uses the first letter of each line to spell out the topic or subject matter.

S ubjects to learn  
C urrency to teach  
H omework to complete  
O utside recess to run around  
O utstanding teachers to guide  
L eaders to model for others

## Cinquain

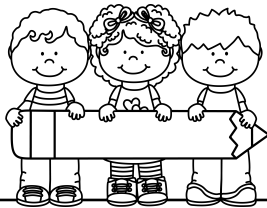
Cinquains are five line poems. There are different ways to write a cinquain. One way is: two syllables in the first line, four syllables in the second line, six syllables in the third line, eight syllables in the fourth line, and two syllables in the fifth line.

## Couplets

Couplets are two line poems that end with a rhyme.

Example:  
School is a place to learn and grow.  
Every day we show what we know.



## Synonym Diamante

1<sup>st</sup> line: One word stating subject  
2<sup>nd</sup> line: 2 adjectives about subject  
3<sup>rd</sup> line: 3 -ing words about subject  
4<sup>th</sup> line: 4 words/sentence about subject  
5<sup>th</sup> line: 3 -ing words about subject,  
6<sup>th</sup> line: 2 adjectives about subject,  
7<sup>th</sup> line: One word stating subject  
Example:

Student  
intelligent, smart  
learning, growing, questioning  
Ready to achieve success  
reading, writing, sharing  
motivated, excited  
Pupil

## Haiku

Haikus are three line poems.

1<sup>st</sup> line: 5 syllables  
2<sup>nd</sup> line: 7 syllables  
3<sup>rd</sup> line: 5 syllables

Example:  
Successful students  
Growing and learning each day  
Exciting school year

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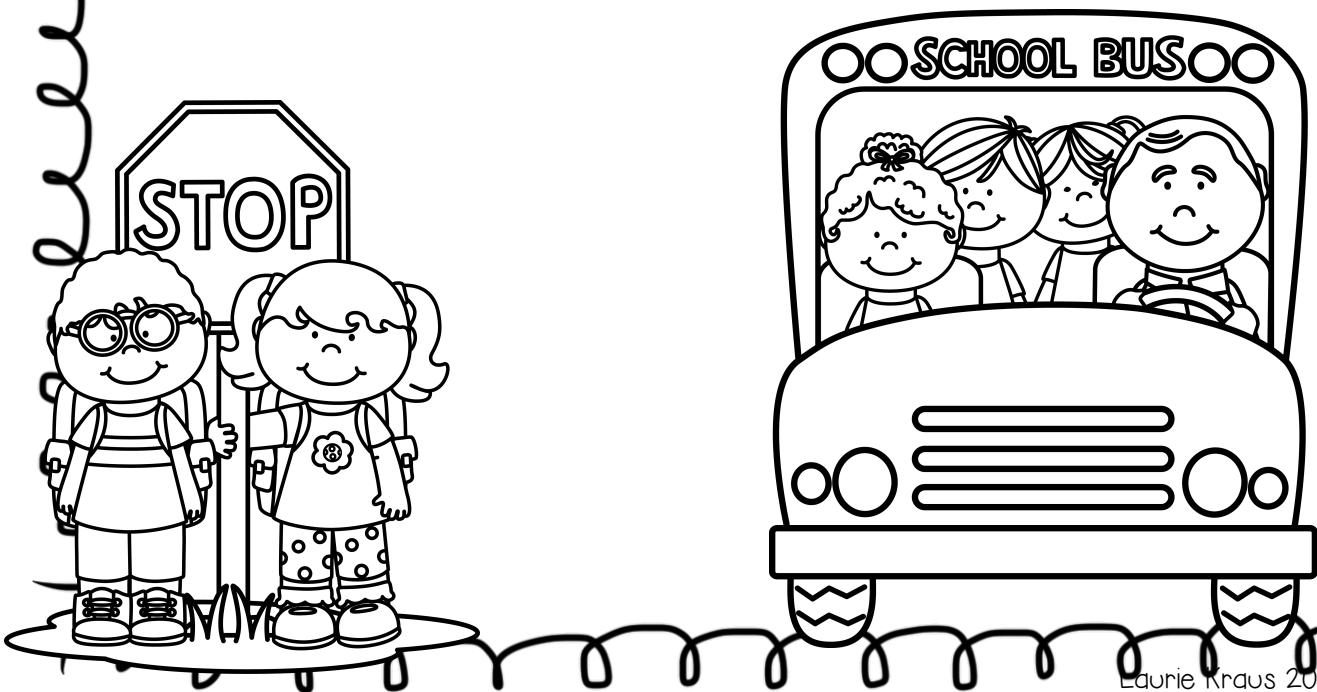

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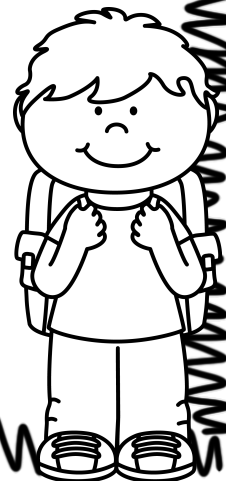
