COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ MAGNIFYING GLASS/GLASSES
SAME: glass, help you see better, can break
DIFF: in hand-on face, make things bigger-clearer, handle-no handle, Dr. prescribes glasses
- ①⑧ WORM/FLY
SAME: live outside, small, part of nature, animals
DIFF: crawls/flies, no wings/wings, worm lives in dirt

SOCIAL

- ⑧ sad, depressed
- ⑨ "It's not your fault.",
"Sometimes these things happen.",
"Bugs often don't live very long.",
"Let's look for another one."
- ①⑩ Put it back in the dirt

DESCRIBING

- ①① WORM: crawls/slithers, soft, slimy, long, in dirt/outdoors, part of nature, comes out in rain
- ①② LEAF: part of a plant, grows, green, can change colors, has a stem, on a tree or flower
- ①③ MOTHER: person/family member, has a child, takes care of us, works hard, an adult, a woman/female

- ①④ they are recycling - you have to separate different materials, or separate trash from recyclables; trying to help the environment
- ①⑤ glass, paper, trash
- ①⑥ take the bins to a recycling center, put them on the curb for pickup, put the bins away

COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ PLASTIC/GLASS
SAME: clear or colored, for bottles, materials, can recycle
DIFF: flexible-hard, not fragile-fragile, glass in windows
- ①⑧ RECYCLE/TRASH
SAME: get rid of, city picks up, put in cans
DIFF: recycling gets reused, good-bad for environment, paper/plastic/glass-food, need to sort recycling

SOCIAL

- ⑧ frustrated, angry, annoyed
- ⑨ "Please don't do that again.", "Let me show you where that should go." "This container is for plastic only."
- ①⑩ Clearly label all the bins, explain what he is doing to others, teach a lesson to the community about recycling

DESCRIBING

- ①① BOTTLE: container, holds liquid, clear or colored, has a cap, plastic or glass, recyclable
- ①② PLANT: nature, grows, green when healthy, need sun and water, has leaves and stem
- ①③ APRON: you wear it, goes over clothes, keeps clothes clean, tie around neck/waist, used when working/cooking

COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ POT/GARDEN
SAME: place for flowers, have dirt, things grow
DIFF: in & outside-outside, need to water-rain, pot can break, pot is smaller
- ①⑧ DIRT/SAND
SAME: dirty, on ground, part of nature
DIFF: clumps-grains, garden-beach, dark-light

SOCIAL

- ⑧ ashamed, embarrassed, guilty, upset, stressed
- ⑨ "I'm sorry!", "I'll be more careful next time." "How can I help to clean it up?"
- ①⑩ Offer to help clean it up, get a broom/dust pan, apologize

DESCRIBING

- ①① POT: container, put plants & dirt in it, round, has base/sides/open top, used for flowers
- ①② FLOWER: plant, grows, pretty, has roots/stem/leaves/petals, needs dirt/sun/water, can be in a pot or in a garden, part of nature
- ①③ CURTAIN: household decoration, hang it, covers windows, made of fabric, goes inside a house, can open/close them

- ①⑨ & ②⑩

COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ BASKET/BOX
SAME: containers, holds things, used to organize
DIFF: wicker-cardboard, handles-no handles
- ①⑧ GLOVES/APRON
SAME: wear them, protection, can be in kitchen, used for working
DIFF: hands-body, no ties-tie/straps, pair-one

SOCIAL

- ⑧ angry, frustrated, exasperated
- ⑨ yell, take him back outside
- ①⑩ keep the outside door closed/locked, gate off the area she has cleaned, have someone keep an eye on him

DESCRIBING

- ①① GLOVES: wear them, keep hands clean, made of rubber, have fingers, keep them with cleaning supplies/under sink
- ①② BASKET: a container, put things in it, use to carry things, has a base/sides/handles
- ①③ RAG: used to clean things, made of fabric, wipe with it, use with cleaning spray, keep with cleaning supplies, usually old/dirty

COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ CARD/LETTER
SAME: writing, send/mail them, paper, go in envelope
DIFF: you open a card, card is thicker paper, letter has more writing, buy cards at the store
- ①⑧ COUCH/CHAIR
SAME: furniture, sit on them, wood, in living room
DIFF: soft-hard, multiple-one person, chair at table

SOCIAL

- ⑧ angry, sad, frustrated
- ⑨ guilty, ashamed, sorry, embarrassed
- ①⑩ apologize, help clean up the milk/spill, try to wipe off the card, offer to help her make a new one

DESCRIBING

- ①① BOUQUET: a group/bunch of flowers, hold it, pretty, colorful, can be wrapped in ribbon, often used in weddings
- ①② CARD: write in it, give to someone, celebrates an occasion, goes with a gift, made of paper, mail/send it, goes in an envelope
- ①③ COUCH: furniture, sit on it, rectangular, soft, made of wood/stuffing/springs/fabric/leather, has cushions/back/arms, in living room

COMPARE & CONTRAST

- ①⑦ JEANS/SWEATPANTS
SAME: clothing, put on legs, have legs/waist, long
DIFF: rough-soft, button/zip-elastic, sweatpants are more casual, jeans can be tight, denim-cotton
- ①⑧ SUNGLASSES/HAT
SAME: wear them, accessories, protect from sun
DIFF: eyes-head, lenses-brim, plastic-fabric

SOCIAL

- ⑧ irritated, mad, frustrated, ashamed
- ⑨ they might feel good about what they are doing to clean up, remorseful, sorry
- ①⑩ "I hope you won't make the same mistake again.", "Did you learn a lesson today?", "Great work today!", "See how great it feels to do something good?"

DESCRIBING

- ①① RECYCLING BAG: container, put bottles/plastic in it, blue, made of plastic, keep it in kitchen
- ①② T-SHIRT: clothing, wear it/put it on, made of cotton, has sleeves/neck, casual, wear in summer, keep in dresser, can be v-neck/crew-neck
- ①③ WEEDS: plants, grow, not good, people try to get rid of them, green, have roots/leaves, need water/sun, in the ground

- ①⑦ BABY/PUPPY
SAME: both young, needy, have to clean up after them, might pee/poop on things
DIFF: human-dog, skin-fur, hands-paws, cry-bark
- ①⑧ BOOKCASE/CLOSET
SAME: in house, to store things, shelves
DIFF: no door-door, books-clothes, hang things in cl.

SOCIAL

- ⑧ exhausted, tired, stressed, frustrated
- ⑨ take a nap, give the baby to the other person, give the new person a big hug, say thank you, leave
- ①⑩ offer to hold the baby, make lunch, take the baby somewhere out of the house, let the dad take a nap, offer to feed the baby

DESCRIBING

- ①① BABY: young human, cries, wears a diaper, drinks milk/formula, sleeps in a crib/bassinet, has legs/arms/eyes, etc., likes to be held/rocked
- ①② TEDDY BEAR: toy, cuddle it, soft, fluffy, for children, made of stuffing/fabric
- ①③ BOOKCASE: furniture, store things on it (books, photos, etc.), for organization or decoration, rectangular, hard, made of wood, has shelves, in a living room/bedroom

SAME: drinks, liquid/runny, in glass/bottle
DIFF: colored-clear, sweet-flavorless, water from tap, juice from fruit, sugar-no sugar

SOCIAL

- ⑧ "Ew!", "Yuck!", "I don't like this.", "What is this?"
- ⑨ "Just try a little.", "It's really yummy!", "Healthy food makes you strong.", "Would you like something else?"
- ①⑩ she might be hesitant, might ask what the food is first, might want to feed herself instead






